<u>Almost One Hundred Bid Farewell to St. Helena's Beloved City Clerk After 36</u> <u>Years of Service</u>













Delia Guijosa took a job with City Hall when Lowell Smith was Mayor. Thirty-six years, 11 months, eight mayors, five city managers and two promotions later, St. Helena's City Clerk has retired.

While her official day of retirement begins April 15th, the celebration began on Friday, April 4th at the St. Helena Fire Hall where nearly one hundred fans gathered to toast her accomplishments and retirement.

Delia was recognized by former mayors, councilmembers, city managers for her years of valuable and dedicated service and culminated in testimonials from State Senator Lois Wolk and U.S. Representative Mike Thompson read aloud to Delia by Mayor Ann Nevero.

In a tearful address to all those who gathered to celebrate her, Delia recounted her time in St. Helena, "I've had a long run with the city of St. Helena. My family moved here when I was five, I attended all three local schools and graduated from St. Helena High. Many wonderful things happened here in St. Helena. I grew up here, got married, moved to Napa, but I still called St. Helena my home because I spent most of my time here. Fortunately my mother owned and lived in the house that I was raised in, her home here was our home. On council meeting nights I would stay the night in St. Helena, it was convenient — sometimes meetings would go until 1 in the morning."

The celebration continued through the evening with a live Mariachi band as Delia mingled with all her friends, family and coworkers. It was a joyous evening to remember and celebrate the 36 years of dedicated and personal service that Delia provided to the community of St. Helena. Congratulations on your retirement Delia Guijosa!


Community Workshop City of St Helena Housing Element Update

A Community Workshop on the City of St. Helena Housing Element Update has been scheduled for Tuesday, April 29, 2014 at the Fire Department Training Room from 7 pm to 9 pm. State law requires the city to adopt its updated Housing Element by January 2015.

The Housing Element is part of St. Helena's General Plan and provides goals, policies, programs, and strategies for addressing local housing needs. Your feedback and comments will help to shape possible housing strategies in St. Helena and help to reflect the ideas and set the vision for our community.

Countywide Transportation Workshop



Attend a community workshop to discuss the Napa Countywide Transportation Plan!

Vision 2040: Moving Napa Forward is the process currently underway to prepare a long-range transportation plan for Napa County. The plan will set policy and spending priorities for the county's transportation system over the next 25 years (through the year 2040). Toward this end, the Countywide Plan will analyze future transportation conditions countywide and recommend a set of projects and programs to address the county's transportation needs.

Vision 2040 is being led by the Napa County Transportation & Planning Agency (NCTPA). The process will address all aspects of the transportation system, including local streets and roads, freeways, public transit, walking and bicycling. Particular attention will be paid to the transportation needs of low-income communities.

NCTPA is relying on the public's involvement to help shape the Plan. The first major opportunity for Napa County residents and others to be involved is a series of community workshops taking place around the county the week of April 21, 2014 (see below for details). At the workshops, the public will have the chance to learn more about the project, voice their transportation needs and concerns, and share their ideas for improving the transportation system.
